All trainers are members of the Zambian Council for Healthcare Professionals and meet continuing professional and training standards in our internal medical audits on an annual basis. All trainer qualification are regulated by the Health Professions Council of Zambia and all AHA courses are regulated with the National Resuscitation Council in South Africa, to meet South African Guidelines.

# SES First Aid Level One and Two

## (Introduction to First Aid)

This one day training course offers students a comprehensive look into the theory and practical applications of basic first aid.

Students are taught to recognise both medical and emergency situations and to apply certain early intervention skills necessary to improve patient outcomes. First aid level one provides a foundation for further training in the field of first and emergency care.

First aid level two offers students further insight into managing medical trauma and incidents affecting both adults and children.

This course runs over a single day and costing includes all equipment and disposables necessary for training. Both theoretical and practical examinations are required for certification and competency after the course. The pass rate for written examinations is 75%.

## SES First Aid Level Three

(Advanced First Aid)

The advanced first aid course furthers the knowledge and skill bases of the first aid level one and two candidates. This extensive course provides rescuers with sound knowledge and practical ability required to provide early care in adult, child and infant related emergencies.

This course is run over four full days, with theoretical and practical examinations to ensure clear understanding of student competency in the concepts of advanced first aid. The pass rate for written examinations is 75%. You will be sent your manual 3 weeks in advance and are expected to study the manual before attending the course.

## Text Books and First Aid Kits

Textbooks are provided on all first aid courses and are included in the cost.

First aid kits are not included in training courses, but are available for purchase from the SES offices.

## Course Outline and Dates

For a detailed outline of the first aid level one, two or three course syllabus, please contact the training department directly. Course dates will be provided on request. Should you require training on an alternative date, a minimum of 6 students are required for booking.

Courses offer a maximum of 12 placements, and booking is made on a first-come basis. Groups larger than 12 require additional instructors and quotations for this can be arranged.

## Certificates

Candidates who have successfully completed the theoretical and practical examinations at the end of each course are awarded a certificate of competency from SESSEC.

Examinations are based on theory and practical skills covered during each course. Your manual will be sent to you in advance and you are expected to study the theory before attending the course. You are unlikely to pass the exam if you have not studied in advance of the course.
